# Graduation is commencement— not an ending but a beginning!

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

About 2 dozen people I know or more, graduated from something this spring! And yes, I do know that there are endings and good-byes in that; some sad good-byes, some daunting "adulting" to be done, some joyous finishings, and likely every feeling in between. But the word used for most graduations is Commencement - and it means the beginning of something. As we begin whatever that next thing is, for those of us who graduated or not, among other things, we continue to grow as disciples. We are in the season of the year of the church's growth-not necessarily in numbers, (though that would be great, too; invite your friends to worship and everything else we're doing this summer!) We join, and re-join, and continue to join God's mission in this congregation, in this town, in this state, in our country and our world. And because of forgiveness given to us by God in Christ, and because the Holy Spirit lives in us, urging us to grow, we seek out Jesus' words, and try, strengthened by God's holy supper, to follow those words. Here are some good ones;

Jesus said: "To you who are ready for the truth, I say this: Love your enemies. Let them bring out the best in you, not the worst. When someone gives you a hard time, respond with the energies of prayer for that person. If someone slaps you in the face, stand there and take it. If someone grabs your shirt, gift wrap your best coat and make a present of it. If someone takes unfair advantage of you, use the occasion to practice the servant life. No more tit-for-tat stuff. Live generously.

Here is a simple rule of thumb for behavior: Ask yourself what you want people to do for you; then grab the initiative and do it for them! If you only love the lovable, do you expect a pat on the back? Run-of-the-mill sinners do that. If you only help those who help you, do you expect a medal? Garden-variety sinners do that. If you only give for what you hope to get out of it, do you think that's charity? The stingiest of pawnbrokers does that.

I tell you, love your enemies. Help and give without expecting a return. You'll never—I promise—regret it. Live out this God-created identity the way our Father lives toward us, generously and graciously, even when we're at our worst. Our Father is kind; you be kind.

Don't pick on people, jump on their failures, criticize their faults—unless, of course, you want the same treatment. Don't condemn those who are down; that hardness can boomerang. Be easy on people; you'll find life a lot easier. Give away your life; you'll find life given back, but not merely given back—given back with bonus and blessing. Giving, not getting, is the way. Generosity begets generosity."

(The Message) Luke 6: 27-38

Like you, I fail. (If you've been to worship lately, I don't need to tell you that.) And I struggle to do what I intend, to finish what I start, to do what I ought. But also, like you, I have this gift in Christ, that every day, even more often, if necessary, I begin again. Forgiven, loved, full of possibility! Let's keep beginning again together, friends!


