"At the crack of dawn on Sunday, the women came to the tomb carrying the burial spices they had prepared. They found the entrance stone rolled back from the tomb, so they walked in. But once inside, they couldn't find the body of the

Master Jesus. They were puzzled, what to make of this. Then, out of nowhere it seemed, two men, light cascading over them, stood there. The women were awestruck and bowed down in worship. The men said, 'Why are you looking for the Living One in a cemetery? He is not here, but raised up. Remember how he told you when you were still back in Galilee that he had to be handed over to sinners, be killed on a cross, and in three days rise up?'"

(from Luke 24, The Message)

We know the stories. We know the endings. We know how we often feel during this Lenten, and then the Easter season. We go thru the motions of lives that may or may not acknowledge that anything could make a difference to us.

Are we happy with what is going on in our country? Or maybe we have enough in our lives that we aren't even looking beyond the confines of our own lives... Is it the medical report we're waiting on - and afraid to know the outcome of? Is it the behavior of someone we love that we just can't live with anymore? Maybe the pressures of our work - or our friends - or what our parents expect of us - are just too much. Or maybe we love someone who is suicidal - or cutting themselves - or medicating emotional pain. Perhaps we know someone who has fabricated a story so big that we're sure it's going to come apart pretty quickly.

What would happen if we listened & watched for how we might share in the awe of the women at the tomb? Can Jesus' resurrection make a difference in our lives today? That is it's promise! For all of us! To quote a colleague, ELCA pastor




